In this case, it's Jamie, an Irish boy with a lovely singing voice. He and Handel help each other. Handel desperately needs a good, strong singer for the premier performance of "Messiah." Jamie needs help. His poverty-stricken, widowed mother arranged a scholarship to a high-class prep school; the school bully makes Jamie's life miserable. Then Jamie's mother, a laundress, is put in debtor's prison. Jamie is shown doing her laundry work at night, and trying to be a student by day. One can imagine how frustrated he'd become.
