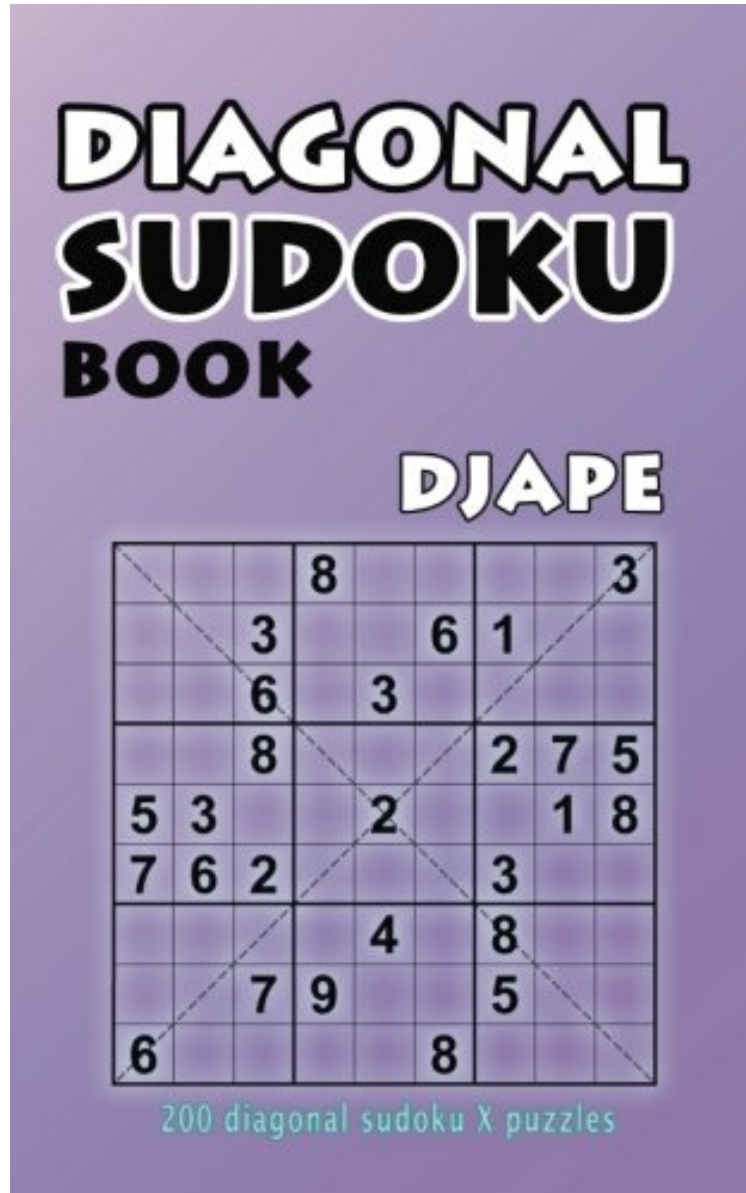

By Gert Bo Thorgersen During my searching after a book with difficulty Sudoku puzzles I bought this book after in reading the 2 recommendations, but must admit that I have found it to be too a book with too many easy to solve puzzles. In the book the first 64 puzzles are called Brain while when in looking into the book there they are called Easy, and are not containing the same puzzles. And the next 86 are in the book are called IQ, while in we see that there they are called Thinker. And in the book the last 50, of the 200 puzzles, are called Insane, while they are not shown in .9 years ago, I by the weekly Danish engineering newspaper, then received a double-sided writing about Sudoku, and with 3 Sudoku puzzles, and there read that research then had found the Sudoku to be the best training for the brain (since then another, and a bit better puzzle has come), so I then started on daily, in the afternoon, solving at least 1 Sudoku puzzle. These 3 Sudokus, in the engineering news, were from concurrences and extremely difficult to solve. I have never in any of the Sudoku books which I have bought found anything just close to the problems in these 3 Sudokus. The most difficult of the many 9*9 Sudoku books which I until now have found, have been the book written Frank Longos Beyond Black Belt Sudoku, which I actually finished just before I received this book written by Djape. And still Im searching after books with harder to solve 9*9 Sudoku puzzles. Of course, I also sometime have bought books with Sudokus much bigger than only 9*9, but normally I only have time to solve a single 9*9 Sudoku, that is, as I want to look on the actual problem from start to finish.

This is a book of diagonal Sudoku puzzles. They are also known as Sudoku X. Both diagonals must contain one occurrence of each number from 1 to 9. All puzzles can be solved without guessing and have one solution only. If you need help, you can always peek at the solutions. Remember: do not guess! The book is small in size but the numbers are printed in large font, easy to read.
