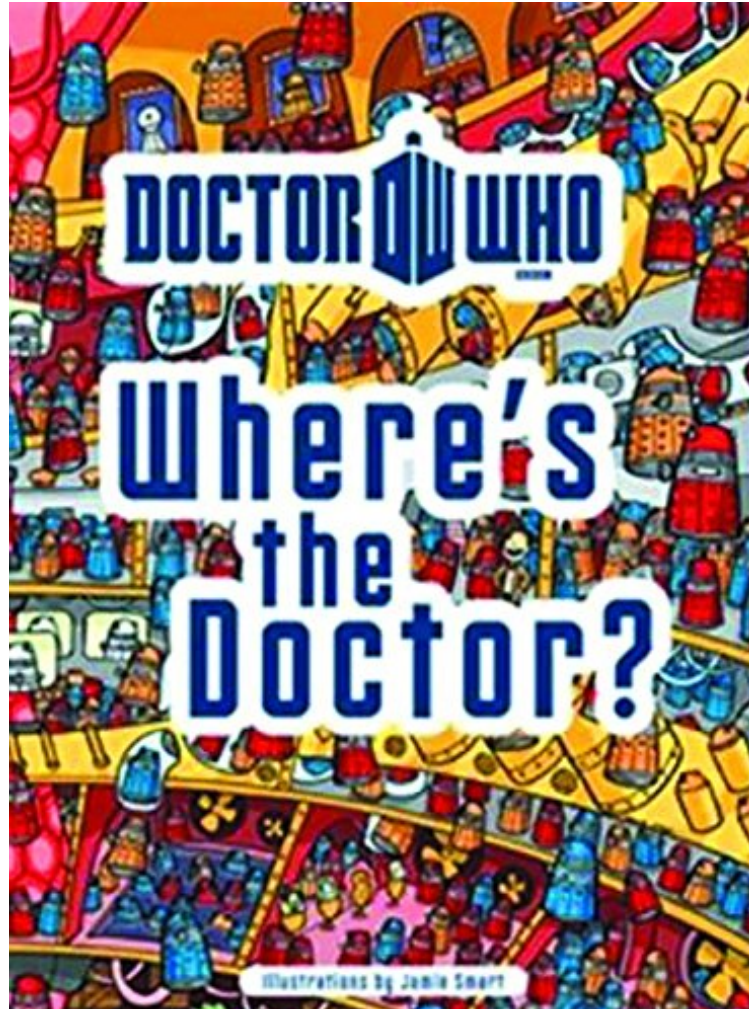

The characters in the pictures are too large,

making everything easy to find. In addition, it feels like the characters/people in the scenes are copy and pasted dozens of time to fill up the pictures. It was amusing and sad to spot the exact same Silurian/Sontaran/whatever in the same stance (some of them reversed) all over the picture. This was not as good as *When's the Doctor?* overall.
