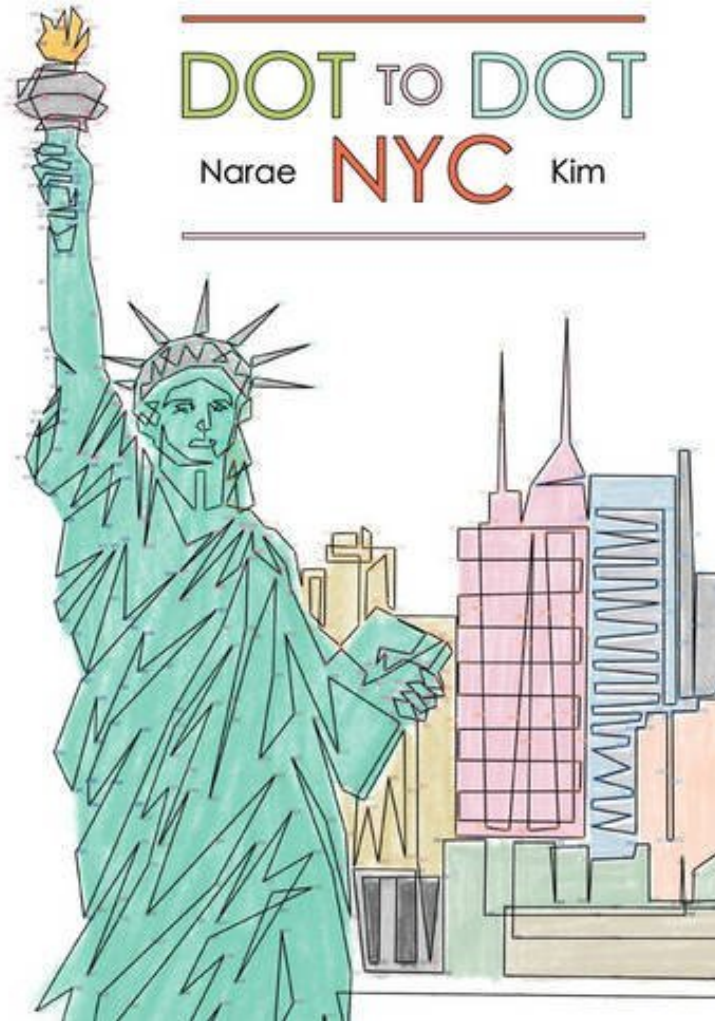

I could see them but it hurt my eyes. Anyone with less than perfect vision will need a magnifying glass! Also, I would suggest the publisher include the names of all the buildings (maybe on a single page at the back of the book. while some are such iconic building that my daughter recognizes them, others are not).
