It proposes that the elegance of Mendelssohn's method has almost completely obscured the fact that it is a method at all. With scholarly detail, the book reveals how Mendelssohn's extensive and carefully constructed strategies reflect a successful attempt to create a specifically Romantic sonata style. Musicologists and theorists, as well as the educated music-lover, will find this a fascinating study.
