Several of them consisted of just 2-3 notes (pitches), For me, this was much, much too minimal, other than the Bach Jesu, they are so basic that they are not musical, no one is going to want to hear you play these, other than the Bach. An OK book I guess for someone really truly just starting in music at all. The book is poorly and really not professionally made as well. After I learned the Bach, which I could have just done by ear, I put the book into the wood stove for the sake of the BTUs, not a keeper. 4 of 4 people found the following review helpful. A couple of them sound a little better when played an octave higher, but overall I wasn't too impressed.
