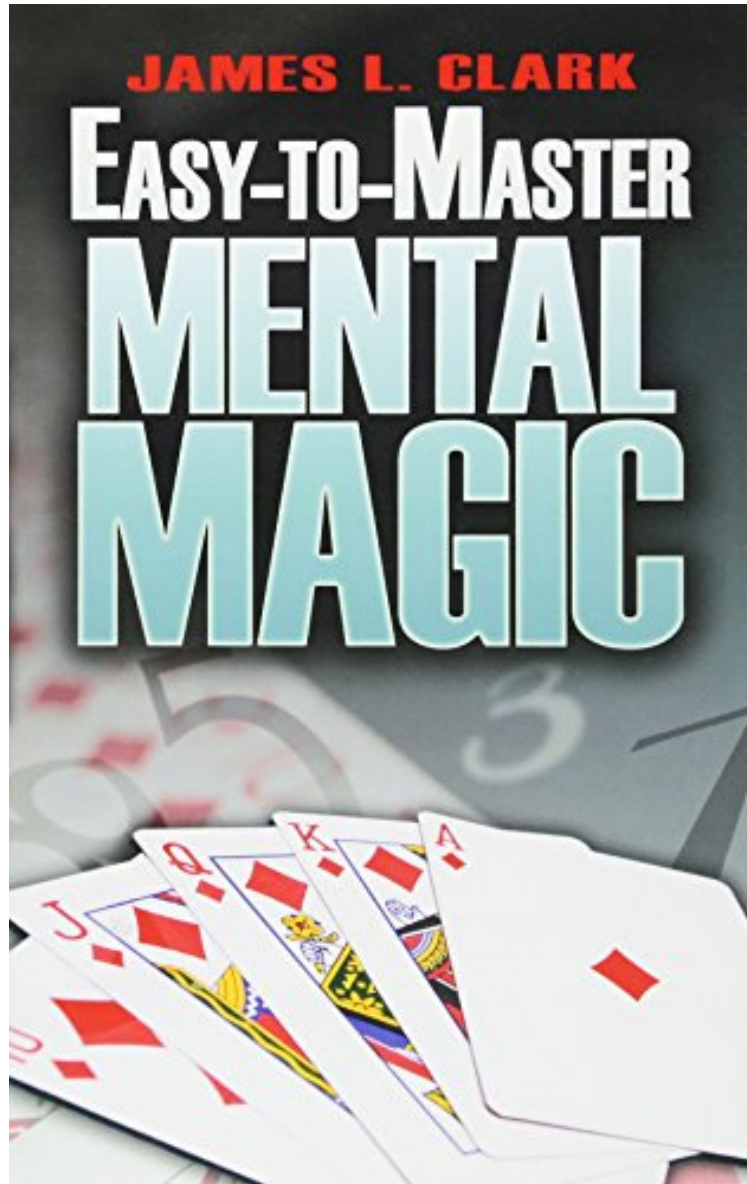

After first glancing through the table of contents and flipping through the pages, I began reading this book from the beginning; starting with the preface. By the time I got to page 40, I counted no less than 14 typos; either misspelled words or the use of the wrong word. But overlooking that, the book has some decent workable tricks. If you're into mental/math magic, I highly recommend this little 109 page book.

Learn to read minds, conduct hypnosis, and predict the future! Instead of employing visual magic, the tricks in this book help aspiring performers exercise mental powers that seem downright supernatural. Seasoned magician James L. Clark shares his professional secrets with 15 psychological illusions that require little practice and even less effort to perform.
