Just ran across it today while rearranging tapes and CDs, and listened to it again. As a forever fan of this famous broadcast journalist from his radio days through early TV, I well remember his long list of great programs, from "Hear It Now" on radio, through "See It Now" on TV, to the wonderful "CBS Reports" series that paved the way for all later TV investigative reporting and has seldom been improved upon. This short, 45-minute audio includes selections of Murrow's most famous work: WWII broadcasts from the rooftops of London during the Blitz and bombers over Berlin; the chilling "Harvest of Shame" program from CBS Reports; and the dramatic commentary calling out the innuendoes, lies and falsehoods of Senator Joseph McCarthy when most others were afraid to challenge that twisted demagogue of false patriotism. Most surprised that copies of this audio are now selling for \$66 and up, but I'm not ready to sell my personal original copy. If you value great journalists and history, and can find a copy of this tape at any price, you will be treated to hearing a man whose voice and mind comes closest to God, and led the way for Walter Cronkite, Huntley and Brinkley, and others who

followed in his path.
