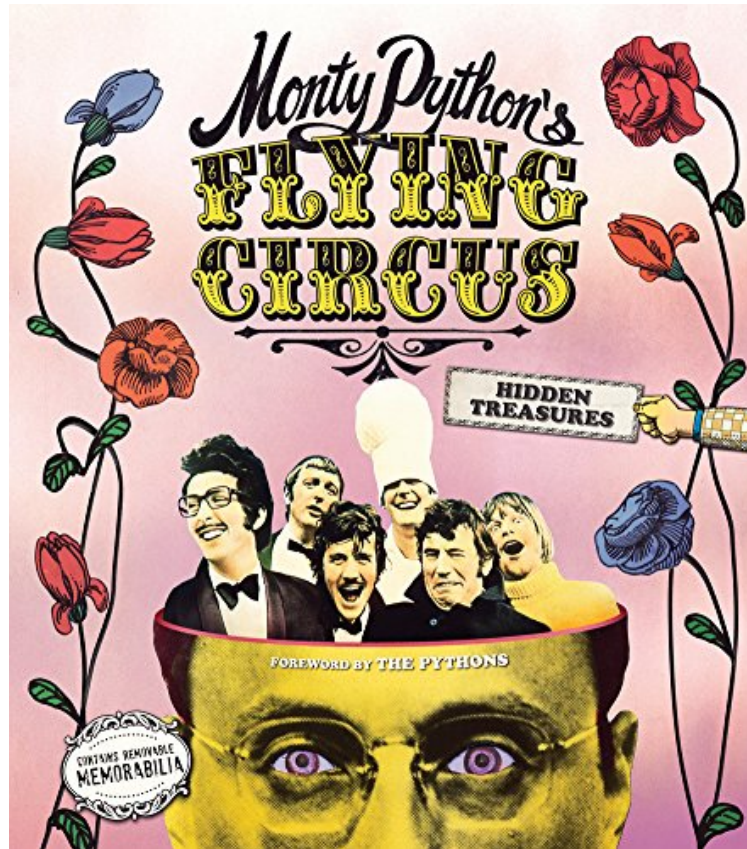

Written with active input from the Pythons themselves, the book recounts the adventures of all six members and their TV show, from early days in the Cambridge Footlights through early appearances on the BBC, global stardom, the inevitable fights, and their triumphant reunions.

He went on to write for a variety of children's television series, including the classic *Wombles* and *Upstairs Downstairs Bears*. He grew up an avid fan of Monty Python's *Flying Circus* and has realized a dream in spending his time researching and writing this book.
