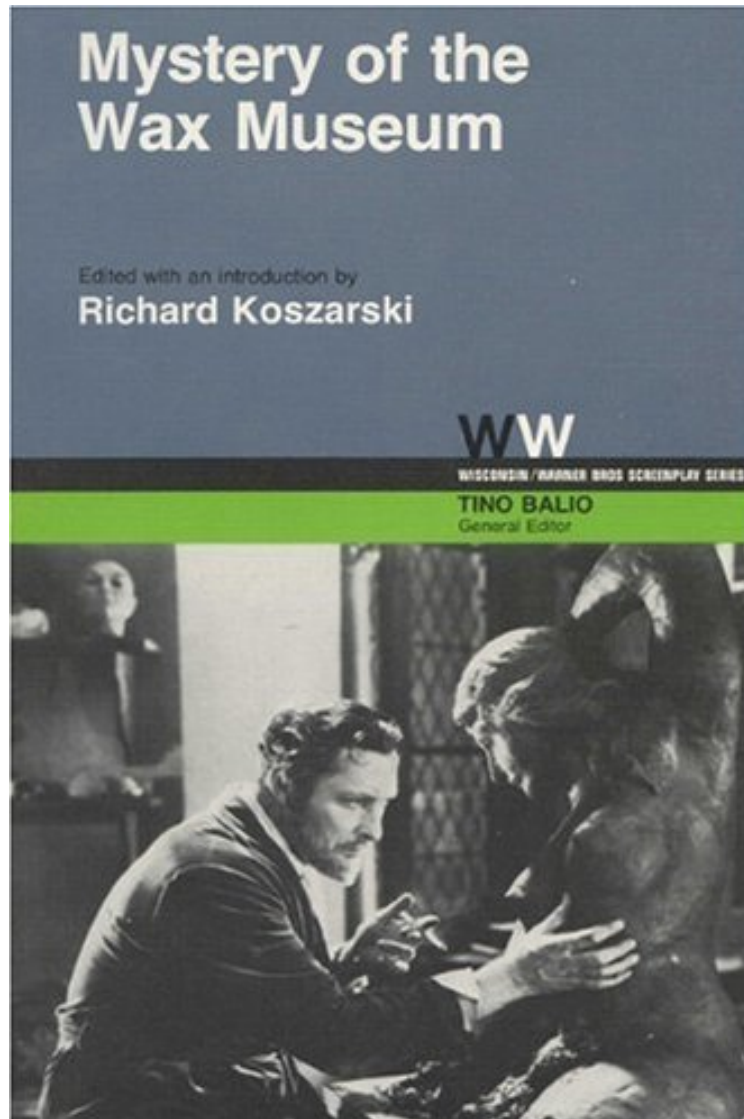

The Depression-era vogue for horror and the supernatural produced some of Hollywood's most memorable chillers, among them *Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde* (Paramount), *Frankenstein*, (Universal), and *King Kong* (RKO). At Warner Brothers, the main entry was *Mystery of the Wax Museum*, directed by Michael Curtiz, a grand thriller of 1933 in which Fay Wray (Who would appear opposite Kong later that same year) was threatened with waxy immortality by the maniacal Lionel Atwill.
