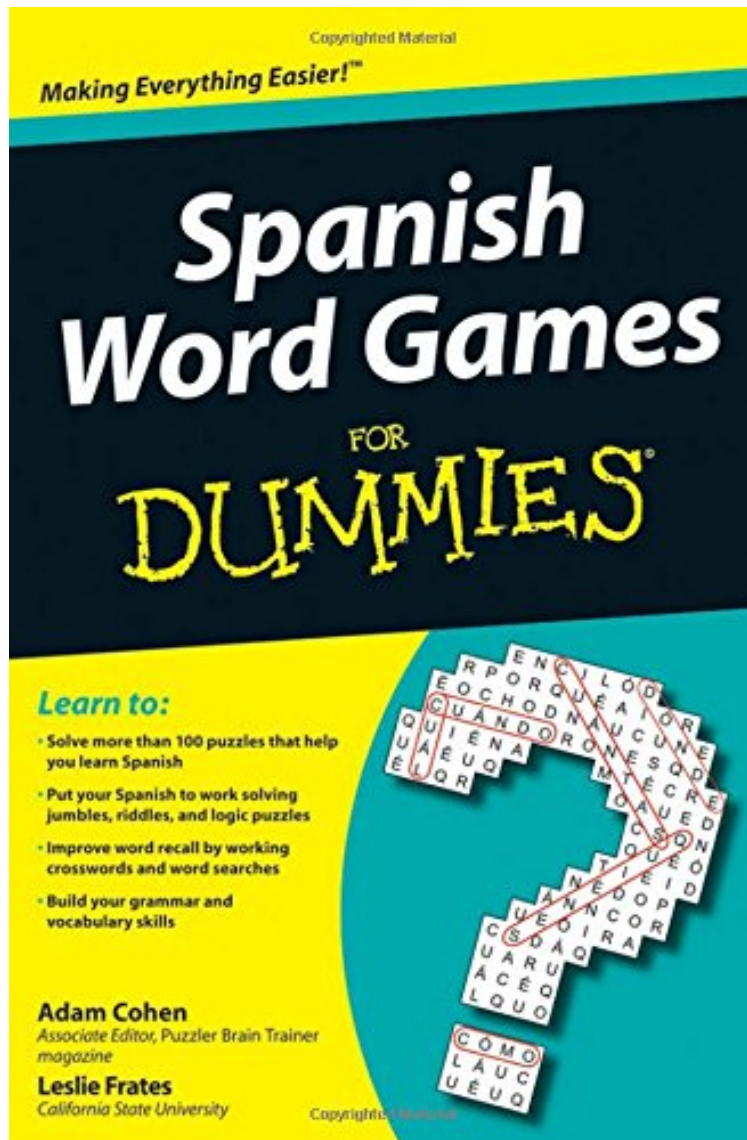

One bummer: for most of the puzzles, clues are given in English for Spanish answers, and vice versa, and there's not always a way to tell if you've got the right word. Many times I "solved" an entire puzzle, and upon checking the answer (provided in the back of the book) found

that the totally correct word I had chosen was not the one preferred right answer. Also, many of the "right" answers were uncommon or outdated words.
