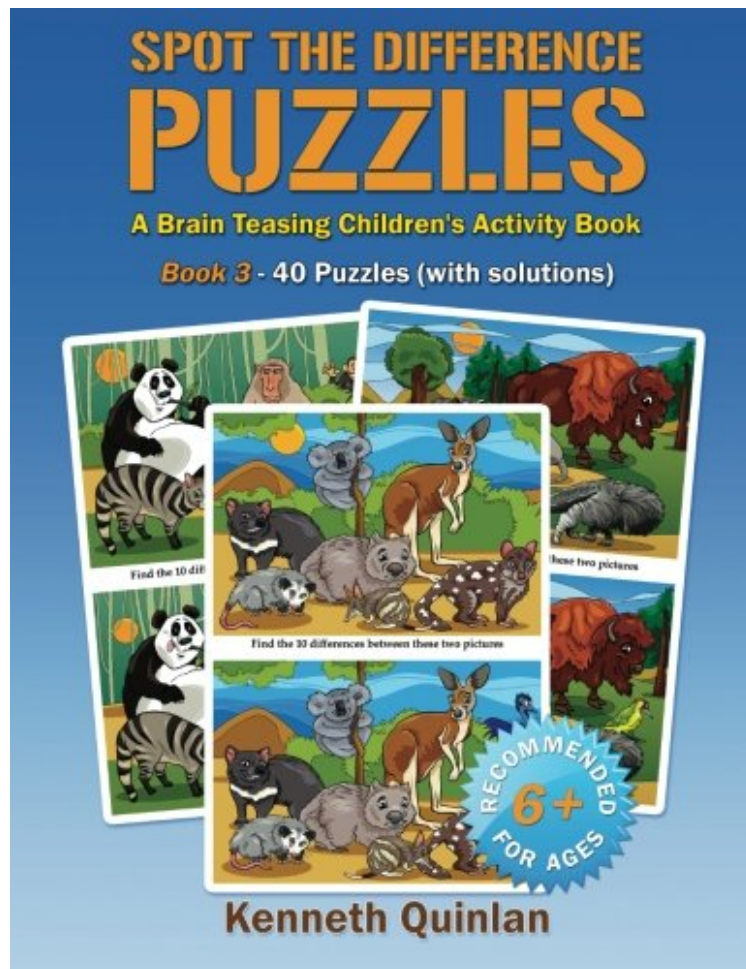

Each set of pictures contains 10 differences, and finding them helps your child to develop a range of skills including observation, attention and concentration, as well as providing an excellent way to improve the memory. Unlike the print version of this book, you cannot mark the differences as you find them, and this is particularly useful when it comes to developing the visual memory. This also raises an important point. This is not a game or an app. designed for interactivity, but is a book created to help develop a range of skills, while also providing a great deal of fun at the same time. So, move away from the game boxes and tablets and cell phones and enter the fun and investigation of Kenneths SPOT THE DIFFERENCE PUZZLES this time with Book 3 the emphasis is all on animal images!. With forty sets of two part pages the differences between the pictures is subtle a fine challenge for the discerning eye. Fortunately turning the page shows the differences circled. This is a key to making the puzzles challenging but also rewarding to the child who has found all the differences and can check the results of comparison simply by turning the page.
