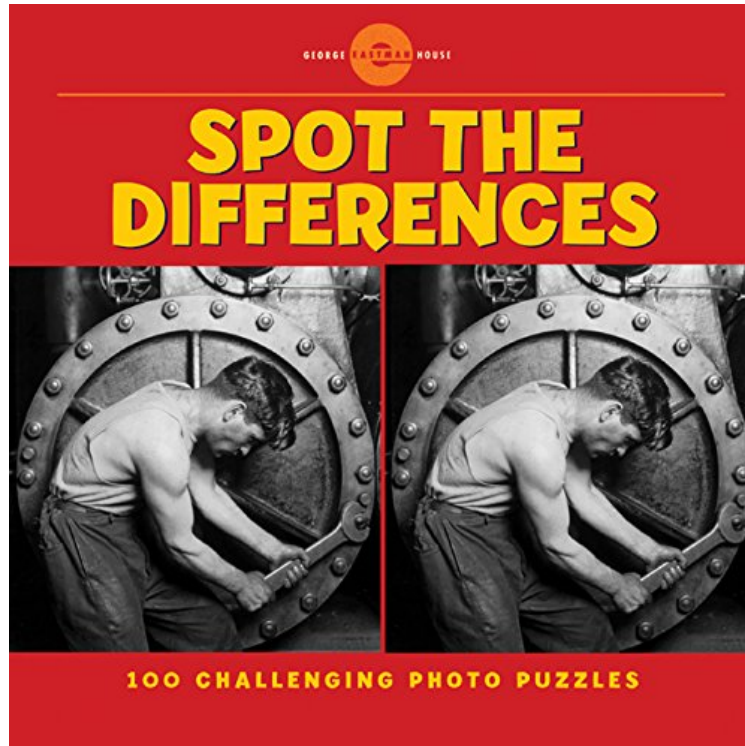

SchultzThis book made my flights go by in seconds! It seems that two different people did the EASY portion vs the MEDIUM AND HARD portions. The EASY portion was harder than the MEDIUM AND HARD! The one who photo shopped the EASY portion was clever with his subtle differences that fit right into the photo context. Whereas whoever did the other two sections would insert stupid things like squirrel heads and stuff that didn't fit into the photos whatsoever. The differences between the 3 sections was only that the Easy had (5) differences, Medium (6) and Hard (7). But the real difficulties were the work of the photo shopper, so that made the EASY section the hardest which was much more satisfying! I would love to know who did the work in the 3 sections and would love to give a big Kudos to the Easy section photo shopper! The Medium and Hard were just plain STUPID and it was obvious that they were by different people. By and large, I agreed with what some people said that some pictures are dark and small making it very difficult (sometimes even impossible without a magnifying glass) to spot the differences. But I do enjoy working on them anyway. If you love looking at professional photos especially those of the old days, you will definitely enjoy this book. The book itself is not very thick, just half inch making it portable especially when you travel.

What makes this book of spot the differences puzzles so unique? Simply put: the quality of the photographs. Every one of the pictures comes from the acclaimed George Eastman House archive, with some dating back to the 1800s. So they make stunning art as well as absorbing brainteasers. In every case, you'll get two versions of the picture side by side; they'll look almost alike, but one is slightly different from the other. It's up to you to search the images and find the variations. The puzzles come in three levels of difficulty: easy with five differences, medium with six, and hard with seven. The photos encompass historical figures, famous buildings, stunning landscapes, and engaging animals and many are iconic works by renowned photographers. The most famous include *The Migrant Mother* by Dorothea Lange; *Lewis W. Hines Power House Mechanic*; and the amazing portrait of Abraham Lincoln taken by the celebrated Civil War photographer Matthew Brady.
