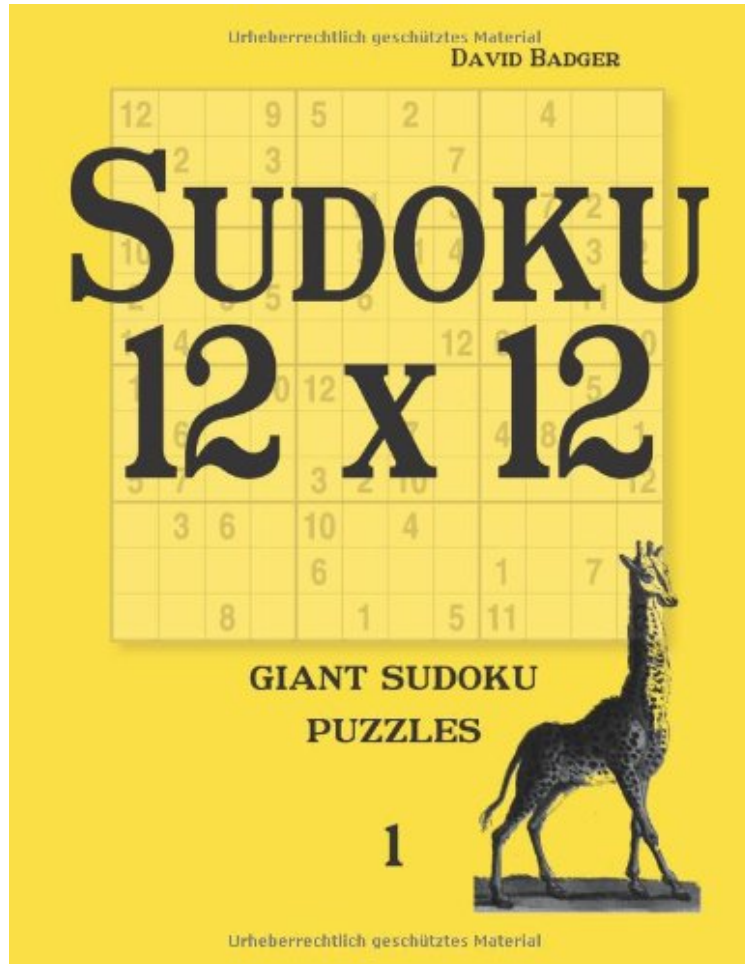

However, eight or ten of these came to what I call a "standoff" in the blue book. There were pairs of numbers at the end that could be a "either/or". Uneven By Cynthia As an inveterate sudoku solver, I was disappointed in this collection. The quality of the puzzles was uneven. I'm accustomed to Will Shortz's collections, which are pretty well organized in terms of difficulty. In this book, some puzzles were easy and I zipped through them, some were just what I liked and it took me hours to figure them out, some were mercilessly hard and I spent days. There was no order or indication of that difficulty level, though. Worse, and to my mind unforgivably, some puzzles did not have a single solution. It would get down to the place where I would have

two numbers and four spaces left, and it was up to me whether I cared to put 2 then 8 in one column and 8 then 2 in the other column, or whether I'd prefer to put 8-2 and 2-8. That's untidy, and it never happens in Will Shortz's books. ON EDIT: Having worked all the puzzles now, I'm pretty well convinced they are computer generated and probably never worked by an actual person before the book was printed. A lot of the patterns are the same; I learned to recognize the same sequences done with a different set of numbers. I will not buy from this series again.
