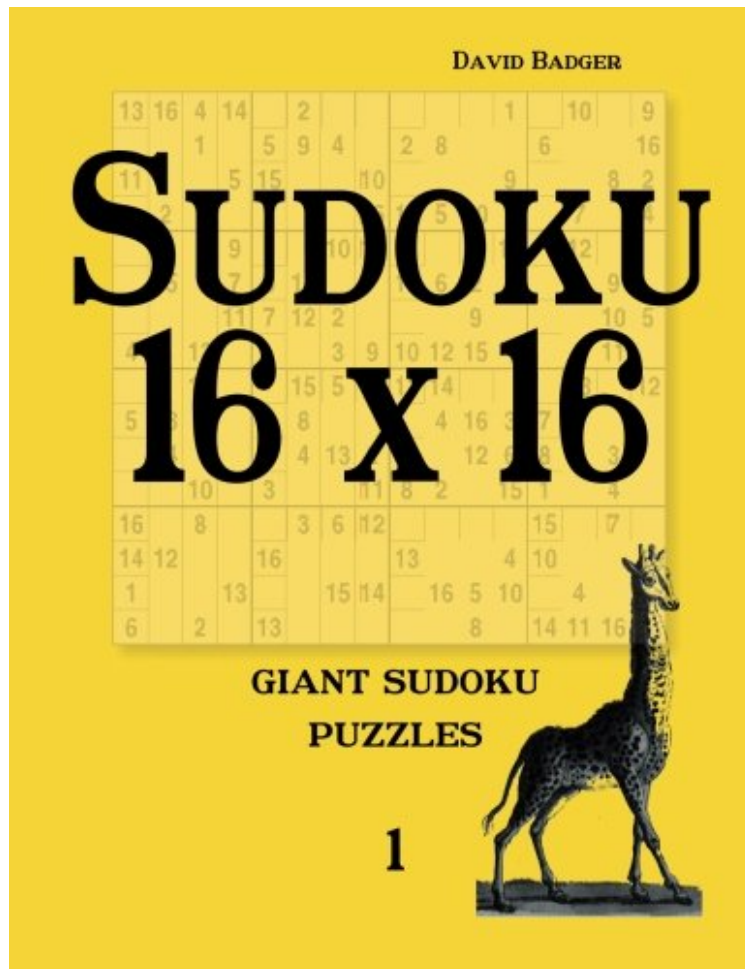

It would have helped had the squares been larger. I found it difficult to read so many numbers in a tight fit. Even more frustrating, there was simply not enough room to jot down the possible numbers in the squares, and there were more numbers to jot down because of the increased possibilities! I have been skipping from puzzle to puzzle out of frustration, and haven't finished a single one, which is absolutely not how I work any sudoku book. The puzzle itself extends from border to

border on sides. I cut the puzzles out and paste them to quadrille paper to have work space and eliminate the extraneous entries in the book.
