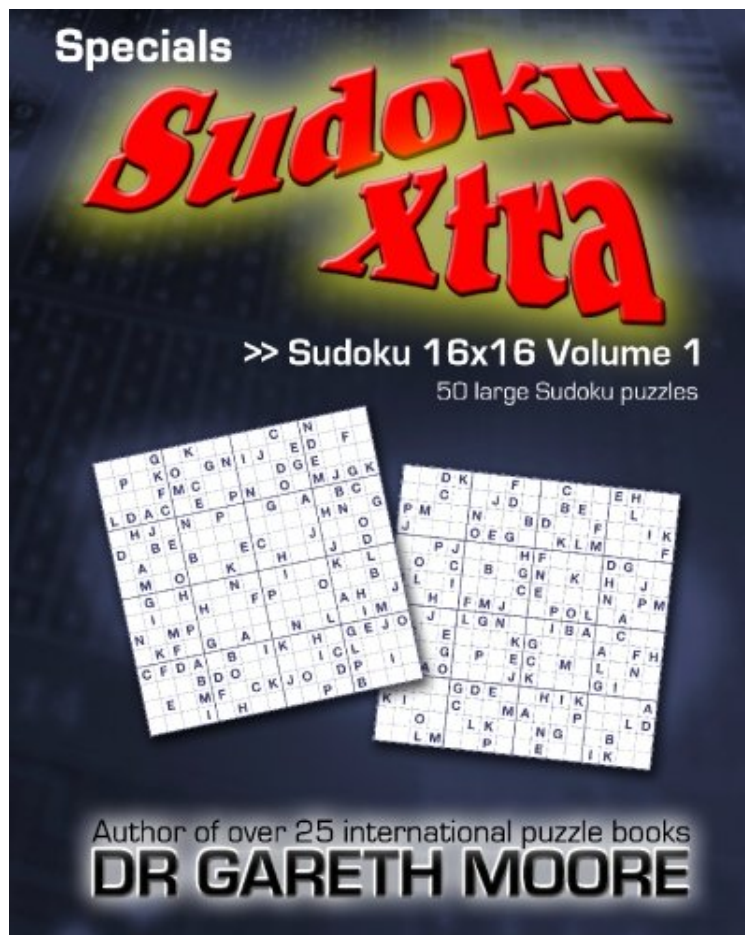

I think the super-easy ones are a little too easy (there's not even a challenge there, so I didn't use the first 1/6 of the book), and I wish the challenging ones were more challenging. Usually when I get to the most challenging sudoku in one of these books, it takes me a long time just to figure out how to get going on the puzzle, and that's part of the fun and the challenge of it. But even the hardest ones were pretty easy to start. Nevertheless, it's a great book for passing time on an airplane or while waiting for the dentist, or a nice book to use while relaxing on the beach if you still want a little mental

The pages are a good size,but a little more space for scratch work would have helped.The only weird thing is that instead of using numbers 0-9 and letters A-F, he uses numbers 1-9 and letters A-G. Others I have seen use the 0-9, but not G. (Computer hexadecimal notation also is 0-9 and A-F.)
